REGULATION 8-16 January, 2020

The Chess Academy of Armenia (address: Shevchenko 34, Yerevan, RA) is organizing “Andranik Margaryan Memorial” which will take place from January 8 to 16, 2020. Participants up to 18 (boys and girls) will take part in different age groups. Each tournament is a 9 round Swiss Tournament.

The total prize fund of the tournament is **2 050 000** AMD. Participants who will take 1-3 places will be awarded with medals and presents.

In case of a tie the monetary prizes will not be distributed, and tie breaks will be carried out according to the cutoff Buchholz, Buchholz and number of games played with black pieces. No player can receive more than one prize.

In the tournaments can participate those who have:

A1 tournament: with a national rating (girls-at least I chess rank)

A2 tournament- at least I chess rank

A3 tournament -at least II chess rank

A4 tournament -at least III chess rank /participants born in 2012 and 2013 – at least IV rank, participants from region – at least 1st norm of IV rank/

A5 tournament – at least 1st norm of IV rank

B tournament -at least III chess rank /participants born in 2012 and 2013 – at least IV rank, participants from region – at least 1st norm of IV rank/

National and international ratings will be calculated in A1 and A2 tournaments. The participants of A1 and A2 tournaments should have FIDE ID / in order to acquire FIDE ID apply to the Armenian Chess Federation in advance/.

Time control: 90 minutes for the whole game with 30 seconds increment for each move, starting from move one.

- for A1 and A2 tournaments - 5000 AMD, (in A1 tournament players with national rating under 2000 - 6000 AMD),
- for A3, A4, A5 and B tournaments - 4000 AMD.
